APICS NoCo Education Course Registration Form

Please complete and submit your registration form here, sending it to bob@supplychainpro2know.com. We'll arrange for payment processing separately.

Certification classes are offered publicly and privately.

We provide ONLINE classes with a regular schedule during the year.

As we confirm your registration, we finalize the schedule as needed.

For ONLINE classes we need a min of 4 registrations to confirm the schedule. We usually start classes 3 times a year;

- January/February
- May/June
- September/October

For INPERSON classes we place you into our planned class roster by your preferred region as demand is identified;

- Metro Denver
- Broomfield/Boulder/Longmont
- Loveland/Ft Collins/Greeley/Cheyenne

Classes with insufficient enrollment are rescheduled to the next cycle.

Payment

Once we have a minimum to proceed with the class, we will notify you. We request **payment to be completed 4 weeks ahead of the class start** to allow time to order materials and provide advance assignments for the first class.

We prefer checks but we will accept credit/debit cards or PO's. **Terms are Due Upon Receipt.**

Format

- **On-line classes** with a Live Instructor, flexible schedules available.
- **Weekday** classes are generally 3 hrs one evening per week, typically 5P to 8P for the duration. CPIM = 25 weeks, CSCP and CLTD = 13 weeks.
- **Weekend** classes are generally 8 hours on Saturdays allowing for 1 hour for lunch, running 8A-5P. CPIM = 9 weeks for both parts with a break between, CSCP and CLTD = 5 weeks.
- **A new option – 5 days consecutively** - when you just want to get it done quickly!
- **A minimum of 4 paid registrations to make a class.**

What is Included?

APICS cert review course includes the courseware, APICS Learning System, access to the APICS e-learning back office with practice resources and diagnostic tests, APICS Dictionary, one Exam Credit Voucher per module, (CPIM has 2) and instructor supplied materials. ASCM Plus membership is required for the certification programs and is purchased additionally from APICS directly.



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State and Fed funding for APICS certification and veterans is also available.

Unemployed, you may qualify for *WIOA Grant Funding, Colorado Department of Labor and Employment. We can also arrange a payment plan schedule.

Workforce Innovation & Opportunity Act, for unemployed persons –
This grant program typically pays all or most of the cost of the APICS NoCo certification programs as approved education providers. Individuals must apply to receive grant money. The local WFC, Work Force Center offices administers this for each county. You must personally apply for and meet specific requirements which can take a few weeks. Program Descriptions

APICS - Certified Production Inventory Management (CPIM), (recommended as prerequisite for CSCP/CLTD)

This comprehensive course is to help prepare professionals for the CPIM exams. Designed in 2 parts,

- Part 1 is the Basics of Supply Chain Management that runs approximately 30 hours followed by -
- Part 2 going into a wide range of topics in more depth covered in approximately 45-50 hours.

It is designed as the world's leading foundation on supply chain management for the practitioner managing strategies, tactics and operational decisions for a factory or a contract supplier. CPIM is based on APICS BOK, Body of Knowledge for CPIM certification with 2 exams known as the CPIM Exam Content Manual. The full CPIM is \$3699 (add ASCM "PLUS" membership) and can be purchased in 2 parts. This course will include TFC, The Fresh Connection SC Simulation platform in the Part 2 class.



- The APICS CPIM program takes an in-depth look at the production and inventory activities within the internal operations of a company and provides an in-depth view of competencies, including:
 - Demand Management/Forecasting
 - Master Scheduling
 - Production Planning
 - Inventory Management
 - Supplier Management
 - Quality Improvement
 - Production Control and Capacity Management
- The APICS CPIM program is divided into five process-oriented topic areas:
 - Basics of Supply Chain Management
 - Strategic Management of Resources
 - Master Planning of Resources



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- Detailed Scheduling and Planning
- Execution and Control of Operations

APICS - Certified Supply Chain Professional (CSCP)

This course is to help prepare professionals for the CSCP exam. It is designed as an advanced supply chain management certification for the practitioner working at management level, dealing with global sourcing challenges, international trade, transportation and logistics. CSCP is based on having APICS BOK, Body of Knowledge building from CPIM certification. CSCP has a pre-requisite of;



- hold a conferred bachelor's degree or equivalent
- hold an APICS CPIM, APICS CIRM, APICS CSCP, APICS SCOR-P, APICS CLTD, APICS CTL, APICS CPIM-F, APICS CLTD-F, APICS CSCP-F, C.P.M., CPSM or CSM designation
- possess at least three years of related business experience

Included in the CSCP Learning System is the CSCP Exam Content Manual, list of Key Terminology and practice exams as well as supplemental resources. Candidates must submit their eligibility statement in order to schedule their exam at one of multiple testing centers throughout Colorado.

The \$3395 course (add ASCM "PLUS" membership) is approximately 36 hours including;

- Module 1: Fundamentals of Supply Chain Management
- Module 2: Supply Chain Strategy, Design and Compliance
- Module 3: Implementation and Operations

This course is to help prepare professionals for the CLTD exam. It is designed as a comprehensive supply chain management certification for the transportation and distribution practitioner working at management level, dealing with global supply chain challenges, international trade, transportation and logistics. CLTD is based on having APICS BOK, Body of Knowledge and as with CSCP, the CLTD has a pre-requisite of;



- hold a conferred bachelor's degree or equivalent
- hold an APICS CPIM, APICS CIRM, APICS CSCP, APICS SCOR-P, APICS CLTD, APICS CTL, APICS CPIM-F, APICS CLTD-F, APICS CSCP-F, C.P.M., CPSM or CSM designation
- possess at least three years of related business experience

CLTD course runs \$3195 (add ASCM "PLUS" membership) including these modules;

- Logistics, Capacity Planning and Demand Management
- Order Management, Inventory and Warehouse Management
- Transportation and Global Logistics Considerations
- Logistics Network Design, Reverse Logistics and Sustainability

ISCEA - Certified Supply Chain Analyst (CSCA)

S&OP Aligned – 1/2 Day workshop

Principles of Executive S&OP, Executive S&OP requires alignment with the hands-on participation of executive management, from the top down starting with the president (COO, general manager, managing director, etc.). This approach is vital to good execution by proactive decision making based on alignment to business objectives;

1. Planning requires top-level ownership and leadership supporting clarity and alignment.
2. Is a decision-making process that balances demand and supply and sets the tactical direction of the business going forward with high confidence and clarity.
3. The planning cycle is monthly, with provisions for mid-period changes when major changes or interruptions may occur.
4. An aggregate planning tool, the volume level plan authorizes plans and schedules for mix related issues and priorities supporting the strategic objectives of the firm.
5. Functions are reflected both in units and dollars.





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- 6. S&OP is highly cross-functional and collaborative. The groups responsible for developing the plans are accountable for their execution with alignment in the larger business environment.
- 7. An integral part of Executive S&OP is a review of actual performance with focus on proactive decision making.
